Understanding, conservation and geotourism March 06-09 2018, Voguë, FRANCE



Held under the auspices of the Public Joint Union of Chauvet Cave, the symposium is scheduled from March 06th to 09th 2018 in (<u>Voguë, Ardèche</u>, South of France). It will bring together 100 experts to discuss the latest advances dealing with understanding and development of subterranean environments.

With the 1st Symposium "To know and share karsts and caves: understanding, conservation and geotourism" we want to encourage exchanges between scientists and managers in karst environments. The exchanges will take place during three round tables focusing on the involvement of scientists in the development of subterranean environments, the importance of developed caves in their territories and the long-term view of global geotourism.

This symposium, open to all, is available on registration. Exchanges will be both in French and English (simultaneous translation). It will be possible to exhibit posters.

Participants are encouraged to submit an abstract about their presentation in order to contribute actively to the symposium. Abstracts will be considered for poster or oral presentation during round-tables by the scientific board.

We would like to collect your abstract and transparency before your talk, unless you use complicated functions in the slide. Please send your abstract to dhuguet@lagrotte.fr as soon as possible by email and talk slide to the same address. Abstracts of your oral presentations or posters should be prepared and submitted online by February 15th 2018.

If the file size of your slide is more than 10MB, we cannot receive the file by an email. In the case please transfer your slide by using wetransfer.com (or equal).

The best format is PDF, but PowerPoint is also available. If you need to use animations or other complicated functions, you may use your own laptop for your presentation. In that case please tell us if you need to check the connection between your laptop and the projector.

INFORMATION FOR POSTER AUTHORS

A poster should be prepared with maximum size B0 [1000mm x 1414mm]. The conference secretariat will provide magnets to fix up the poster on the poster board at the symposium site. You should not use double sided tape.

Each poster author can present his / her work for 5 minutes in front of the audience.
